- 1. This application is compatible with Windows Vista 2000 XP.
- 2. The Demographics heading block (i.e. Name, Date of Birth, etc.) appears when the Demograhically Adjusted norms option is selected from the report window.
- 3. For the WAIS-III tables and graphs, under the Diff between Subtest and Mean table, the p value displays the significance level based on table B4.
- 4. Reference SS scores show in table column for all age groups.

5. Error Analysis contains modifications to skill descriptions and corresponding item

numbers.

- 6. The WIAT-II Written Expression standard score computes during age-based reporting for ages 8:0 8:11, 2nd grade.
- 7. The preferred system settings for this software are 16-bit color, minimum of 800 x 600 display area, and small fonts. To check your settings, select Start | Settings | Control Panel. Click the 'Display' icon and select the 'Settings' tab. Click 'OK' to save any changes.
- 8. When you print reports from cases entered prior to the change for Reading Comprehension, a message window will appear prompting you to return to the Raw Scores tab window and select an item set. The scores for Reading Comprehension will not appear on the report if you don't select an item set.
- 9. The Reading Comprehension Standard Score, not the Raw Score is used to calculate the quartile.
- 10. User should proceed with caution when completing the Error Analysis for 'Oral Expression' because you are able to select all of the set items even though the Error Analysis only occurs with the first nine items.
- 11. To view the product demonstration, the CD-ROM must be in the drive.
- 12. Due to the recent Reading Comprehension changes for WIAT-II, you must have WISC-III--WIAT-II Scoring Assistant Reading Comprehension Service Update, version 1.0.1, installed prior to installing the WAIS-III--WMS-III--WIAT-II Scoring Assistant. You may check the version number by selecting About PsychCorpCenter from the Help menu. Then, clicking the Product Info button to open the Product Information window, which displays the installed products and their version numbers. If you have do not have the Service Update installed on your machine, you may receive the following error message when clicking the WISC-III--WIAT-II report icon:
