Frequently Asked Question:

Incorrect Descriptions: It says that specific descriptions that are inaccurate, non-target responses are scored as one incorrect description. Does this mean that the maximum number of incorrect descriptions for each sort is one?

Answer:

The descriptions for the 2 sorts are scored independently. If a correct score is given to a sort description, it can not be counted as an incorrect sort. However, the second description of the other sorted cards can be wrong. The max score per sorted group description is 1 with a max of 2 per sort.

For example:

Sorted group 1 Sorted group 2

(These are happy) and (these are sad)

Incorrect Description scores: 1, 1 (for sort total of 2)

Sorted group 1

Sorted group 2

(These cards are blue) and (these are happy)

Incorrect Description scores: 0, 1 (for sort total of 1)
