

Is AIMSweb Reading-CBM like a Running Record?

No. Running records and informal reading inventories (IRIs) focus on specific skills whereas curriculum based measures are indicators of overall reading proficiency. In addition, a large body of research has shown that one-minute samples of the number of words read correctly from reading passages are sensitive, reliable, and valid of measures of reading proficiency - there is little research to support the use of running records and IRIs.
