This file includes helpful information about the WAIS®–IV Upgrade to Report Writer. The 1.0.5 update includes the following fixes:

CR 37265	Corrected issue seen when selecting a WAIS-IV index for substitution (i.e., only two of the four WAIS–IV indexes may have a subtest substituted within the index or the index prorated due to a missing subtest (for VCI and PRI only)).
CR 37223	Corrected issue calculating Digit Span Total Raw Score when all process scores are not entered (i.e., Digit Span Backward, Digit Span Sequencing, and Digit Span Forward are all required to calculate composite.)
CR 36856	Corrected issue when generating a WAIS-IV Report Writer report after installing the WAIS-IV Scoring Assistant 1.0.6 update.
CR 35933	Corrected issue when entering an apostrophe in the comments section of the WIAT-II assessment window when running a combined WAIS–IV—WIAT–II report.
CR 35080	Allowed for the WAIS–IV—WIAT–II ability-achievement discrepancy to extend above 19:11 years. Range includes up to age 85:11. The values reported for the ability-achievement discrepancy comparison are based on examinees aged 16:0 to 19:11 years.
