CELF-IV Scoring Assistant has these available Report Options. The basic reports include:

- Summary (brief scores)
- Out-of-Age-Range Testing (Appears for Ages 8 thru 21:11, when applicable)
- Discrepancy Comparisons (Compares Indexes with each other-Differences, Prevalence, and Level of Significance.)
- Graphs (comparing Cores, Indexes, Subtests, and Percentiles)
- Narrative (canned report that includes the Recommendations & Referral)
- Item Analysis (Shows the selected correct, incorrect, and not administered output)
- Pragmatics Profile (Shows the actual questions that were administered and the frequency (Never, Sometime, Often, Always, or NA).
- Observational Rating Scale
- Confidence Intervals (Allows the user to select a specific level linked to specific norms tables for scoring the various ages.)
