What was the basic norms group for the Short Form?

Answer:

The basic norms group for the short form were FEMALES AGES 19-89 and MALES AGES 16-89.

Are the norms based on normal controls? Does the ceiling effect preclude getting any norms on the younger population. The normative reference sample for the CVLT-II was comprised of 1,087 adults (565 females and 522 males) ages 16 to 89, carefully matched to the most recent U.S. Census in terms of several important demographics variables.

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
